

CODE OF CONDUCT

WYTHE-GRAYSON REGIONAL LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES

RECOGNIZING THAT PERSONS HOLDING A POSITION OF PUBLIC TRUST ARE UNDER CONSTANT OBSERVATION, AND RECOGNIZING THAT MAINTAINING THE INTEGRITY AND DIGNITY OF THE PUBLIC OFFICE IS ESSENTIAL FOR MAINTAINING HIGH LEVELS OF PUBLIC CONFIDENCE IN OUR INSTITUTIONS, EVERY MEMBER OF THE WYTHE-GRAYSON REGIONAL LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES PLEDGES TO ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING CODE OF CONDUCT.

1. Regularly attend all scheduled meetings of the Board of Trustees, as well as special or called meetings relevant to the office.
2. Properly prepare for each meeting.
3. Create a positive environment in meetings of the Wythe-Grayson Regional Library Board of Trustees
4. Maintain an attitude of courtesy and consideration toward colleagues, citizens and staff during all discussions and deliberations.
5. Allow citizens, colleagues and staff sufficient opportunity to present their views within the prescribed rules for conduct of meetings of the Wythe-Grayson Regional Library Board of Trustees.
6. Avoid the use of abusive, threatening or intimidating language or gestures directed at colleagues, citizens or staff.
7. Avoid comments, body language or distracting activity that conveys a message of disrespect and lack of interest.
8. Respect all local, state and federal laws, rules and other regulations.
9. Submit completed financial disclosure forms to the Grayson County Library.
10. Publicly acknowledge and respect the adopted position when asked about a decision of the Wythe-Grayson Regional Library Board of Trustees.
